Emerson was 10 pounds, 21 inches, and he was born on 10-21. Those details will help me remember the date of birth and size of our grandson, but I don't think I would ever forget anyway! Soon after we first met Emerson, Tracy said, "I'm so in love!" Isn't that amazing? We are completely, head-over-heals in love with this little person who has done nothing

whatsoever to earn our love or deserve our love. In fact, a lot of

things newborns do are not even very appealing. (I won't go into that!) An experience like this teaches me in a way like no other what God's love is like for us. God doesn't love us because of what we DO. God loves us because of who we ARE: We are God's. That is enough. I love Emerson because he is my grandson and because he is my son's son. That is enough. This is unconditional love. This is the grace of God flowing through us in love for others.

You know exactly how I was made, bit by bit,

all the stages of my life were spread out before you, The days of my life all prepared before I'd even lived one day. So, as we enter into this special season of Thanksgiving, I am thankful for the miracle of God's love and the way God's love flows through us to all God's Children so they will know that they are loved with an endless, boundless, unstoppable love.

#### <u>Sunday Morning Bus</u> <u>Drivers</u>


The current drivers will continue to provide transportation using the bus when necessary and private vehicles when more convenient.
