The Second Mark: A Methodist Rejoices in God


2. The second session topics will include:



RE-1J students will be on spring break the week of April 3-7. For the nearly 300 kids in our community who benefit from Kids Aid care packages or





My name is Katie Lay. I'm the Director of The Wesley Bell Ringers, a youth handbell choir out of Christ United Methodist Church in Salt Lake City, Utah. I'm writing you to see if your congregation would be interested in hosting us for a performance on our summer tour this year.

I've attached a formal request letter, but I'll give you a brief rundown here. The Wesley Bell Ringers are one of the premiere youth handbell choirs in America. Each year, the choir performs a Christmas concert series, and performs on a two week summer tour to a different area of the United States.

We'd like to perform for your congregation on Saturday evening, June 24th. We would ask that members of your congregation provide us with dinner, beds for the night, an easy breakfast the next morning, and transportation back to the church. Many churches choose to do a potluck for host families and the choir, which eases the cooking burden and allows everyone a chance to get acquainted. This is historically the favorite type of meal on tour. I realize that hosting our choir is a big undertaking, however it's an incredible experience that is absolutely worth it. The opportunity that each church provides our teenagers is unlike anything else available to them, and truly helps to shape them into well-traveled, welcoming adults. I am also incredibly proud to share with you the music that we've prepared.


