Advent—the time of waiting—is upon us. Each year, the Sunday before the four Sundays is Advent, we celebrate Christ the King Sunday! The end of the liturgical/church calendar year. We begin anew with Advent. How appropriate that we start the year with waiting!

Most things in life begin with some type of waiting—from the acceptance letter to college, to the call about the job interview, to the birth of a baby and beyond. Sometimes our waiting can be long and arduous and sometimes our waiting can be short and nearly instantaneous. Waiting, in all it's forms can feel like torture.

So, what if we reframe how we look at waiting? What if instead of torment, we see it as a gift. The gift of waiting allows us to take some time to think about possibilities, to ponder the roads less


